### **Job Title:**

**Research Analyst, The Health of Canada's Children**

### **Role**

Reporting to the Research Director and the Executive Director of the Canadian Institute of Child Health, the role of the Research/Survey Analyst is to perform quantitative and qualitative analysis in support of the research agenda of *The Health of Canada's Children: A CICH Profile*. This is a project funded by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research and a private Foundation. The position will require basic statistical analysis, literature reviews, preparation of brief reports, and other related tasks.

### **Responsibilities**

The Research/Survey Analyst will:

- Under the supervision of the Research Director, be responsible for data analysis on large Statistics Canada datasets such as the Census; National Longitudinal Survey of Children and Youth; Canadian Community Health Survey and others.
- Conduct literature reviews and analysis on selected topics related to children's health.
- Build an on-line repository of references/research materials.
- Write reports on the above research.
- Participate as a team member on other requests.

### **Skills**

- The Research Analyst must be a highly organized, focused and motivated person who works well independently.
- This position requires someone with a strong understanding of survey design and analysis with strong skills in the understanding and use of SPSS, MS Office (Excel, PowerPoint and Word) and referencing software.
- The position requires someone with strong written and communication skills who is able to manage multiple work assignments simultaneously.
- The Research Analyst should have a good understanding of children's health.

## **Education/Professional Designation**

The Research Analyst should have the following:

- A degree in statistics, sociology, public or health administration or related degree with concentration in research methodology and statistics, policy analysis.
- Working knowledge of SPSS and MS Office (Excel, PowerPoint and Word).

## **Experience**

- To qualify for entry into this position, the Research/Survey Analyst can be a graduate student, a post-doctoral student or someone with at least 1 - 2 years of work experience in this area.

## **Time Frame:**

- Fifteen month contract commencing June 2010 with the potential for renewal on an annual basis dependent upon funding.
